SUNY Broome Community College is governed by a ten member Board of Trustees. Five of the Trustees are appointed by the County Executive, with the approval of the County Legislature; four by the Governor; one member is a SUNY Broome Community College student (with voting privileges), elected by student peers.

The College President is appointed by SUNY Broome Community College's Board of Trustees, with the approval of the SUNY Chancellor and SUNY Board of Trustees.

The President is the chief executive officer who reports directly to the Chairperson of the College Board of Trustees and whose governing authority is stipulated in section 604.3 (Responsibilities and Duties of the Presidency) of Codes, Rules, and Regulations of the State of New York, Title 8 Education, Vol. B.

Rapport is maintained with the Sponsor through the County Executive or the Deputy County Executive and Committee Chairpersons/Members of the SUNY Broome County Legislature.

Three key governance units advise the President: the President's Executive Council, College Council and the Student Government Association.

Informal communications are maintained between the President and the executive officers of the bargaining units (3): Faculty Association (FA), Guild and BCC ESPA.
