Doolittle has been awarded the Vanguard Award in Nursing. The fall 2023 schedule is up and live, with registration starting on Monday. BU is preparing to send letters for the new B2B and BAP.

# **Human Resources and Student Finance Update**

New forms and instructions are being developed for processing for the hiring freeze. HEERF annual reports are being completed. Ms. Hodel participated in a call with other processing offices about the new BAP 1.0. program. The first offers will include a link to SLATE with information going to Admissions and Student Accounts. On April 5, 2023, from 7-8 p.m., there will be a virtual open house about the program for parents and potential students. There will be a second open house for current BAP students to talk to incoming students. The college-wide Open House is on April 28. A contract has been signed with Inceptia, which is a

verification system for EOP students but will be offered to all students filling out forms. Financial Aid is working on having some meetings about scholarship awards/financial aid for incoming housing and regular students.
