- B. Distance Learning Steering Committee (Carine Surdey)
 - Meeting Dec 2nd -
 - Blackboard shells for Winter will be created Dec 4th Spring Dec 24 one month before the semester begins one month before
 - Creating them early created issues when things needed to be changed
 - Blackboard will be updated on 12/24 will fix any bugs during maintenance window 12am - 6am
 - Blackboard collaborate will be updating on 12/10 during the maintenance window
 - Bug Fixes and enhancements regarding formatting messages in the chat, increasing the number of participants in a room at a given time (1000 users per room)
 - HyFlex Created listing of considerations and questions for moving toward HyFlex modality
 - Interest and excitement with faculty to try out these modality
 - Presentations will continue on HyFlex workshops you are encouraged to attend
 - CircleIn System that will be implemented in spring
 - CircleIn is a platform where they can communicate with each other outside of the class. Integrated with blackboard and can connect with students
 - Form study groups
 - Flash cards
 - Tutors can be added
 - Instructors can monitor some issues they are having
 - Operates on a reward system as they engage with the platform they can turn in for prizes
 - A CircleIn Core Team is being formed to discuss implementation
 - Student driven How to market this to our students
 - Many SUNY colleges are using this tool
 - Draft list of goals for Strategic Planning to be forwarded to Dr. Haynes
 - Blackboard orientation is ongoing to be completed by Spring
 - All Zoom meetings should be using a passcode
