Distance Learning Steering Committee – Stephanie Malmberg:

- The DLC has not met; all focus has been on the migration and helping faculty prepare for it. The TRC continues to host office hours at least 4 days a week, as well as one-on-one appointments in various modalities to meet the needs of faculty. On November 7, 2022, we have evening office hours available from 5-7:30pm
- 147 trained Brightspace users. We have over 260 accounts created. We have approximately 100 folks on the spring schedule who have yet to request a Brightspace account, which is inclusive of folks teaching in all modalities, not just online.
- SUNY has requested we put a deadline on the course conversions. I will be communicating that date to the campus early next week as part of my Migration Monday Missive.
- Our method of communication is email; we have seen a critical mass of folks asking what next steps are once they have a Brightspace account; all of this information is communicated via email and I am also sending out a weekly email to reiterate the process. We also have a robust website where we publish all of this information.
- We cannot stress enough that we have approximately 6ish weeks until Blackboard goes dark. We believe we have a plan with SUNY for resolving incomplete grades; there are fewer existing incomplete grades than we originally thought, and we will need to work with those faculty who issue incomplete grade contracts for students for the fall semester.
- It is requested that all faculty on this body please bring this message to the folks in your areas.
