- President Update- CA
 - o COI
 - Continue to encourage students to use (at least try) CircleIn.
 - Bridge off I-81 will be under construction due to roundabouts being placed, reroute if you commute that way.
 - o CAI
- Voting on endorsement for ILO on racial justice, motion was made and it passed! April 22nd, 11am-12pm YVM faculty (same time as student YVM)
 - Christina has PTODI on April 6th to get overall update on the next steps for the ILO
- Dr. Drumm
 - Middle states coming up, SA members please attend if you are able.
 - Testing is still going smoothly. Monday-Tuesdays are very hectic for testing, Drumm recommends going Wednesday-Friday.

- Financial Affairs
 - College continues to forecast a balanced budget for the current fiscal year.
 - Major changes in the states budget which ends in 9 days.

- Governors proposal that he can administratively determine is to reduce state aid to community colleges by 5% rather than 20%. Cut of about 650k.
- Academic Affairs
 - Middle states asks questions like "how do you feel about the campus" "what is student government like" "do you feel like your voices are being heard" etc
- Dr. Carol Ross
 - After the Atlanta shooting incident, we will be reaching out and doing wellness checks for our 100 asian students currently enrolled.
 - Bringing on a new resident director Kalis, started yesterday and took Alex's place. Pam stepping into Alex's shoes while transitioning.
- FCCC: SUNY is rebuilding/revisiting their gened policy. Been in place since 1988.
- Trustee Update-F&F and BOT
 - Budget shortfall shrank from stimulus plan
 - \$2.4 million received from CARES ACT
 - Funding reduced by 5 percent rather than 20 percent
 - Waiting to see how much money we are getting from county
 - No increases in tuition or increases in activities fees
 - Federal Audit has found no problems or issues with broome.
 - DOD (department of Defense) Auditing Suny Broome approximately 100 Veterans attending Suny Broome.
 - CDC guidelines may be reduced to 3 feet
 - Testing center mostly commuter students testing positive for Covid.
