Finance & Facilities Update

- We are continuing the operations of SUNY Broome's childcare center for the next year, 2022-2023
- We are acquiring land behind the campus for \$425,000, it will probably be used for the construction of more dorms following BU's and SUNY Broome's integration.
- Upgrading / updating computers across campus
- Upgrading wi-fi to allow for better service
- Increasing hourly wage for tutors A, B, and C to \$14.20, \$14.60, and \$15.10 respectively.
- Locks are being updated in classrooms, labs, and office spaces. Do dorm doors require updates?
