This was a special meeting to discuss the BAP Students as there is confusion between what is being communicated at BU and how it affects SUNY Broome. Jesse Wells has a call with the BU BAP team at 3 p.m. today. There were concerns communicated from them on Friday. BU has told all resident students they can return to their homes and work remotely, but if they chose to leave, they cannot come back to the dorms. BAP students are concerned as they have classes on our campus. BAP students are concerned if they go home and BCC re-activates on campus classes they will have to move back to the area. Most have been directed to talk with their professors.

Dr. Drumm reported that classes will probably not re-activate. The expectation is that anything at a distance will remain at a distance for the rest of the semester. Governor Cuomo's statement is all SUNY colleges must go online as of March 19 to the end of the semester. Dr. Drumm felt that the Governor has no intention of having students return to campuses and is interpreting his guidelines that after March 19, the fewer people on campus the better.

The college will follow the governor's guidance regarding all courses going online, and this will be relayed to the BU BAP students.

## **Essential Employees**

Lynn Fedorchak stated that SUNY would like the number of essential and non-essential employees. Dr. Drumm reported that as of today, all are essential employees.
