# EMMO Update

Public Safety conducted 731 pooled tests as of yesterday, making the number of tests within the 750 -760 range. The county vaccine pod is not running tomorrow. Their goal is to administer 1200 vaccines this week. The EMMO is receiving questions on what the process is for students who have had to be quarantined. How and when is it safe for students to return to the classroom? Verification that the student has been released from quarantine should be released to instructors or Public Safety. Documentation is provided by the county. Will students self-disclose if they know they have to share compliance form? Students have already self-disclosed so this request would not be a violation of privacy. The EMMO is recommending that the quarantine compliance documentation be provided to faculty on a student's return to the classroom. The Executive Council is in full support of this recommendation.
