- Diversity, Equity and Inclusion, handout provided:

- “SBCC - Learning outcome DEI: Describe the historical and contemporary societal factors that shape the development of individual and group identity involving race, class and gender;”
- “SUNY -Learning outcomes - DEI / SJ: (1) Analyze the role that complex networks of social structures and systems play in the creation and perpetuation of the dynamics of power, privilege, oppression, and opportunity; 2) Apply the principles of rights, access, equity, and autonomous participation to past, current, or future social justice action; 3) Within a given field or discipline, students will identify the consequences of racism in the United States at the individual, group, and systemic levels.”
- Gave example of situation in California where race affected value of home appraisal.
- This applies to specific courses, in order for a course to qualify as DEI they need to meet these requirements; currently 20 courses meet the requirement of DEI / SJ

Dr. Wagner

Miss. Ohana & Miss. Hagerdy

- "We have pursued other avenues to resolve this matter" "as neurodivergent students we find concern [with the following]"
- There are not enough offering of in person classes making it difficult to navigate majors that have entire classes only online
- Arts and languages are the main concern of exclusively online options. There are multiple students who have also voiced this concern
- Humanities courses are disappearing and this is very important to not allow this
- Administration "ghosting" aka hiding courses in order to funnel students into other classes
- Anecdotal complaints from other students: Lack of law, art, gym classes, theatre department not given the opportunity to run themselves - under the music department
- BrightSpace not allowing transgender students to display their preferred gender and to hide their preferred name. Tech and admission office have been contacted on this matter and they have not addressed this situation.
- Chosen names and pronouns are available on admission applications but not on BrightSpace specifically
- ***COI - This is SUNY control not SUNY Broome Specifically
 - Marques (Dean of Students) - Can confirm the preferred name is not available on brightspace, working on getting this situation resolved on the tech front through working with SUNY, apologizes for the situation taking longer than expected.
 - Could you clarify the grievance with Accessibility and Gym?
 - Guest has no further information on the topic but has emails of these students available to work on this situation
 - Dr. Mary Donnelly: Theatre *club* has shows coming up so come support! Unfortunately as far as the courses between COVID and the ban on public

gatherings resulted in a hit on the program as a whole. Reorganization is actively ongoing with the ultimate goal of creating a specific theatre major. So in short: Know that it is being worked on behind the scenes and is moving forward even if on the surface it is not always evident. Theatre club meets every-other thursday at 11.
